

Content of Initial medical examination for class 1 (Civil pilot)

1. Clinical examination and mental health assessment
2. Respiratory function – spirometry
3. ECG
4. Chest X-ray
5. Laboratory (CBC, Glucose, Lipidogram, Urin)
6. Urine test – psychological assessment
7. Psychological assessment
8. **Ophthalmological examination: history; visual acuities near, intermediate and distant vision; examination of the external eye, anatomy, media (slit lamp) and fundiscopy; ocular motility; binocular vision; visual fields; tonometry on clinical indication; objective refraction: hyperopic initial applicants with a hyperopia of more then +2 dioptries and under the age of 25 should undergo objective refraction in cycloplegia; assessment of mesopic contrast sensitivity; + colour vision assessment: Ishihara plates (Anomaloscope color vision test if needed)**
9. ENT examination + Audiogram
10. Midterm alcohol consumption testing – CDT
11. Other medical examination if indicated

Content of Initial medical examination for Class 3 (Air Traffic Controller)

1. Clinical examination
2. Respiratory function – spirometry
3. ECG
4. Laboratory (CBC, Glucose, Lipidogram, Urine)
5. **Ophthalmological examination:**
history; visual acuities near, intermediate and distant vision; examination of the external eye, anatomy, media (slit lamp) and fundiscopy; ocular motility; binocular vision; visual fields; tonometry on hyperopia of more then +2 dioptries and under the age of 25 should undergo objective refraction in cycloplegia; assessment of mesopic contrast sensitivity; and colour vision assessment: anomaloscope color vision test
6. ENT examination + audiogram
7. Other medical examination if indicated
